Tell: To proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom

We want to introduce as many people as possible to Jesus. This will be through **Alpha** courses, **schools and young people's work, community work**, raising a congregation of evangelists and continuing to work with other Christian denominations.

We believe in growing the Kingdom rather than just one church and will seek to support other churches and mission organisations. We are committed to becoming a **resourcing church**; supporting and encouraging other local churches in South East Cornwall to grow.

Teach: *To teach, baptise and nurture new believers*

We want to be a place where members are taught, disciplined and challenged in their faith. We are a family of believers who look after the needs of each other pastorally, spiritually and practically. We will offer structured teaching in a variety of ways including **courses, Sunday talk series** and one-off teaching events. We see a Church that doesn't just exist on a Sunday morning, but where each member belongs to a **Life Group**.

We want to be a church with prayer at its heart and where people feel a sense of belonging. We encourage everyone to serve on a **team**. We want to connect with and nurture young adults. We believe in the priesthood of all believers and want to raise up and nurture leaders.

Tend: *To respond to human need by loving service*

We want to love and care for our wider community by following Jesus' example. We will continue our involvement in our local community. We want to pray regularly for our local area, hold prayer and fasting days and take **prayer out into the town and beyond.**

Schools are significant institutions within the community and we want to support them. Children and families are the main focus of our mission and through activities such as ABC, youth groups, schools work, family events and holiday projects - we will support families and young people and find new ways to encourage them to get to know Jesus.



Transform:

To seek to transform unjust structures of society, to challenge violences of every kind and to pursue peace and reconciliation

We want to bring a Christian presence to our community and to reach out to those in need. Jesus went out of His way to help those in need. We currently host the **Liskeard churches CAP centre**, and contribute to the **Foodbank**, offer free meals over the summer periods, work in partnership with **Café Abundance** and distribute hardship and food grants. We want to do more. We also want to continue our support of **mission in other countries** with mission Sunday's, supporting oversees mission families, mission trips to Calais and working closely with CMS and other partners.



Treasure:

To strive to safeguard the integrity of creation and sustain and renew the life of the earth

As stewards of creation, we are committed to protecting the planet God has given us. We want to celebrate **biodiversity** with projects such as Making Space for Nature. We will monitor our progress through the **Green Church Awards** and **Eco Church Awards**. We continue to look towards making our buildings more **sustainable** and efficient.

We want to do our part in **cutting carbon** and have already installed solar panels, energy efficient lighting and underfloor heating in the church. We want to do the same in our church centre and plan to complete a renovation and reordering of the complex. We will do this in order to care for our buildings and make sure they are relevant for their multi-purpose use.

Thrive:

To grow spiritually, numerically and to be financially sustainable

By 2026, we see a church where its members **attend church services regularly**, belong to a **Life Group**, serve on a **team** and **tithe** 10% or more of their income.

Our church is deepening its spiritual roots as we grow upwards and outwards. We need to be Jesus focused. If our hearts are centred on Him, then his concerns will be our concerns and our church and all whom we serve will **Thrive.**
