Life Group Questions

Based on the sermon at 9.15 and 11am services on 8 March 2026.

1. The question on Sunday was "Why doesn't God always answer the way we expect? Have you experienced an unexpected answer to prayer? What did you learn from it?"
2. Read 2 Corinthians 12.1-10 What did Paul learn from his unanswered prayer? Think of unanswered prayers in your own life. What are you learning from them?
3. Read Luke 18.1-8 Do you sometimes 'lose heart' in praying for someone or something? What helps you persevere?

Pray for one another about the things that have come up.

Prayer Points

- War in Iran - pray for peace, an end to retaliation and non-violent ways to resolve conflict
- Youthwork at St Martin's - to grow the leadership team, wisdom for those leading sessions and curiosity for the youth to explore faith and life.
- Halls project as this phase nears completion – thank God for his provision that has enabled this work to take place.

Halls Update

The work on the new roof of the upper hall is entering its final stages. The main work of insulating and re-slating is complete. There is some finishing off still to be done. The solar panels are now in place along with the battery storage which is located in a locked room in the Cellars. The two upper rooms in the hall have had new insulated ceilings and repairs done where damp had caused damaged. Insulated ceilings are currently being installed to the office and the entrance hall. We have also commissioned the building company to repair part of the car park on the south side of the building which will improve drainage of rain water and the overall condition of the car park.

It is likely that we will have access to the Lower Hall car park again in the next couple of weeks with the scaffolding on the north and west sides being removed. The rest of the work is scheduled to be completed sometime in April - so much is weather dependent!

Once we have access to the building there will be a need to thoroughly clean everywhere in the hall before it will be useable again.

Thank you for all your donations and fundraising to get us to this point. This work will ensure that the upper hall remains a great resource for our church and community for the next 100 years!
