
Bishop James - Sunday 12th July

Life Group Discussion Questions — Psalm 13 & Lament

1. Suffering as Part of the Christian Life

- Jesus said, *"In this world you will have trouble."* How does acknowledging this reality change the way we think about the Christian life?
- Have you ever felt guilty for struggling or grieving? What contributed to that feeling?

2. Turning to God

- Why is turning to God—even with weak or confused faith—an essential first step?
- What makes it difficult to turn to God rather than withdraw, numb ourselves, or look for distraction?

3. Honest Complaint

- David expresses his pain upward (God feels absent), inward (his thoughts are overwhelming), and outward (his enemies threaten him). Think about a time of trial that you have been through - or even that you are going through -Which of these three would you relate to most?
- Why do you think God welcomes honest complaint instead of correct but forced prayers?
- Have you ever been helped by someone who allowed you to be honest about your pain? What made that helpful?

4. Asking God for Help

- David asks boldly: *"Look on me and answer."* What does bold prayer look like in seasons of suffering?
- Why is it important to anchor our requests in God's character rather than our circumstances?
- What is one area of your life where you need to ask God for help more boldly?

5. Choosing to Trust

- Psalm 13 pivots on the word *"But..."* What helps you make that shift from sorrow toward trust?
- How does remembering God's *hesed*—His covenant, unfailing love—strengthen trust even when circumstances don't change?
- Can you think of a time when your perspective changed before your situation did?
