Word: Read Genesis 3:1-3 and Ephesians 2:8-10

1. What does restoration from ashes mean to you?
2. Mark spoke of Genesis 3 not being the end game but the start; how do you read this knowing what Jesus would come and do?
3. Ephesians speaks of the Grace of God; what does this mean to you?
4. Both these readings are examples of CAP vision of restoring, CAP vision to restore people's lives with Hope. What does restoration and Hope look like to you?
